
Am I invited from God for service?

The call for service is based on four levels

- Choice
- Communion
- Training
- Evangelism



Choice:

God knows who has certain qualifications for a service, *God invites*.

• Communion:

Is a chance for learning in a communion.

• Training:

The disciples spent a whole year in communion and in preparing for service.


Evangelism

The Choice



(Mark3:13&14)

The Communion

The disciples' communion with Jesus was a chance to learn from him.

They learned when the crowd gathered around him.

They watched Jesus when he was praying with tears, laughing with the crowd and being kind with children.

The Communion



The disciples learned from their master through the sermons. Like the sermon on the mountain and through their individual relation with Jesus.

He told them a lot of things that pertain to the kingdom of God.

The practical Training

Jesus started to send the disciples two by two and he established the fundamental principles for the spiritual and the earthly work:

- 1. The spirit of oneness
- 2. The spirit of faithfulness
- 3. The spirit of simplicity
- 4. The spirit of peace
- 5. The spirit of firmness

The Evangelism
