- PSALM 18:2



Reflection on (Job 37: 14-16)

"Listen to this, O Job;

Stand still and consider the wondrous works of God.

Do you know when God dispatches them,

And causes the light of His cloud to shine?

Do you know how the clouds are balanced,

Those wondrous works of Him who is perfect in knowledge?"
