Peace and grace.

The church is kindly asking you to note the following so that together we keep the church a safe place for all of us:

1. Maintain physical distancing, sanitize your hands and wear your mask at all time while at church. Make sure the mask is properly covering your mouth and nose.
2. Starting December 23, 2021, the Divine Liturgies of Thursday and Friday will be prayed at the main Church not the chapel. That provides more spacing and better ventilation.
3. The total number attending the liturgies has been reduced to 100 persons.
4. Avoid close contact with others. Make sure you are at least two meters apart from others including when standing in the communion line.
5. You are encouraged to leave the church immediately after taking communion to prevent congregating at the foyer.
6. If you have any symptoms please don't enter the church for any reason.
7. Please note that the midnight liturgy for the New Year has been cancelled. Now there is only one liturgy from 9:00 am to 11:30 am on January 1st. Sorry for the inconvenience.
8. Please note that only the second Liturgy will be prayed on Sunday January 2nd 2022. As the first Liturgy is not prayed, Raising of Incense will be prayed 9:30 am - 10:00.
9. Unfortunately the number of people who were tested positive at church is increasing rapidly. As a result, all Liturgies and services are temporary suspended till the evening of Thursday January 6th. God willing registration for the Nativity Feast Liturgies will open in a few days. Please stay tuned as this might change based on the coming government announcement.

According to the government rules you might have to quarantine if you come in close contact with any person who is tested positive for the virus.

We pray that God may end this pandemic and protect the world.
